The White Bow Represents

Purity, Cleanliness, Holiness and Complete Forgiveness Of Sin (Psalm 5:7, Isaiah 1:8, Revelation 15:6, Matthew 17:2)

The Bow Represents

A type of knot with two loops, used to tie together two cords (*one man, one woman*) conjoining in marriage

The Bow Represents

Tying The Knot - As In the Traditional sense of Marriage Between One Man and One Woman

The Bow Represents

Tying A Bow On A Gift Or Present - Marriage Is A Gift From God (Proverbs 18:22, Genesis 2:21-25; Proverbs 5:15-19; John 2:1-11)

The Bow Represents

Taking Back The "Rain" Bow* - as God's Marriage Bow

The Bow Represents

Bow (As In Bow And Arrow)** - Weapon Of War, Conqueror, Overthrow Of Power (Psalm 7:12)

The Doctrine of Truth*** (*Isaiah 5:28, Habakkuk 3:8, 9, Gen. 49:23, 24*)

The Bow Represents

(Same Letters, Different Pronunciation) - Bow Down (Every Knee Shall Bow - Philippians 2:10-11)

The Purple (Violet) Background Color Represents -

Spiritual heart of a nation, Royalty, and The Color Of The Robe The Romans Put On Jesus To Mock Him as the King of the Jews (Judges 8:26, Proverbs 31:22; Luke 16:19 Job 29:14, Isaiah 61:10, Luke 15:22, Revelation 6:11; 7:9;14, Mark 15:17;20, John 19:2;5)
